

FORESTRY USE: Do not apply more than 4 gallons of Martin's Stump Killer per acre per two years. Do not make more than one application every two years. Martin's Stump Killer is highly active, is water-soluble, can move with surface runoff water, and can remain phytotoxic for a year or more if it gets into the soil.

Do not contaminate cropland, water, or irrigation ditches.

Do not contaminate water intended for irrigation or domestic purposes. To avoid injury to crops or other desirable plants, do not treat or allow spray drift or runoff to fall onto banks or bottoms of irrigation ditches, either dry or containing water, or other channels that carry water that may be used for irrigation or domestic purposes.

Do not apply to snow or frozen ground.

Do not apply on residential or commercial lawns or near ornamental trees and shrubs. Untreated trees can occasionally be affected by root uptake of herbicide through movement into the taproot or by excretion of the product from the roots of nearby treated trees. Do not apply Martin's Stump Killer within the root zone of desirable trees unless such injury can be tolerated.

Do not permit any spray or spray drift to contact non-target plants. Use only gravity flow or very low spray pressure.

Small amounts of this product can cause injury to plants. Do not apply on or in the vicinity of sensitive crops or desirable broadleaf plants.

Do not rotate food or feed crops on treated land if they are not registered for use with picloram until an adequately sensitive bioassay or chemical test shows that no detectable picloram is present in the soil.

Do not remove product from original container except as applied under the Directions for Use.

Do not apply through any type of irrigation system.

Mixing and Loading: Most cases of groundwater contamination involving phenolic herbicides such as 2,4-D have been associated with mixing/loading and disposal sites. Caution should be exercised when handling 2,4-D pesticides to take steps to prevent contamination of groundwater supplies. Use of closed systems for mixing or transferring this pesticide will reduce the probability of spills. Placement of the mixing/loading equipment on an impervious pad to contain spills will help prevent groundwater contamination.

APPLICATION METHODS

Tree Injection Treatment

Apply 1 milliliter of undiluted Martin's Stump Killer solution through the bark completely around the tree trunk at 2 to 3 inch intervals between edges of the injector wounds. When using the tree injector, make injections near ground level. When using a Hypohatchet Injector or similar device, make injections 2 to 4 feet above the ground. Treatments can be made in any season. Do not treat maples during the spring sap flow. For some difficult to control species such as dogwood, hickory, sugar maple, bigleaf maple, tan oak, and some firs, make applications to a continuous cut rather than to spaced cuts.

Note: No Worker Protection Standard worker entry restrictions or worker notification requirements apply when this product is directly injected into agricultural plants.

Fill or Girdle Treatment

As close to the ground as feasible, make a single hole guide or "fill" of overlapping ax cuts through the bark completely around the tree. Prune or spray the injured surface with undiluted Martin's Stump Killer, using enough product to wet treated areas.

Stump Treatment Using undiluted Martin's Stump Killer, spray or paint cut surfaces of freshly cut stumps and stubs. Thoroughly wet the cambium area next to the bark.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect residue for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.
